Coronet Bay Community Feedback Survey - Wetlands Project

This survey was conducted by the Coronet Bay Ratepayers and Residents Association (CBRRA). The survey was open to ALL residents and/or ratepayers of Coronet Bay.

The survey was distributed to Coronet Bay Ratepayers and Residents via email or letterbox drop.

The CBRRA were interested in understanding how the Coronet Bay community felt about the proposed Wetlands Project at the retention pond (beach end of Norsemens Road). We greatly appreciate those taking the time to share their thoughts.

Only one survey per person was permitted. Respondents were vetted according to the Coronet Bay address to which they are associated as a ratepayer or resident.

Personal details, names, addresses, email address etc., will not be shared in any way, at any time with anyone, nor with Council.

The Wetlands Project is a proposal only. Bass Coast Shire Council (BCSC), has provided funds to assess the project's viability only. No funding has been provided to commence this project.

The results of this survey are being presented to the ratepayers and residents of Coronet Bay and to the BCSC.

Survey commenced Tuesday, 19 May 2020 and ended midnight, Monday 15th June, 2020.

Online survey link emailed to 190 CBRRA members

Online survey responses = 47

Response percentage: 24.75%

Hard-copy letterbox drop to approximately 580 households

Hard-copy responses = 61*

Response percentage: 10.2%

Total surveys distributed = 780

Total survey responses = 108

Total survey response percentage: 13.5%*

The 108 survey responses from a Coronet Bay population of approximately 900 is a very good sample size (12%) and has a sound statistical (90%) level of confidence, with a margin of error of +/- 7.5%.

*The COVID-19 'stay-at-home' directive was in force during the time of this survey. Many holiday home owners were unable to travel to Coronet Bay and as a result may not have been aware of the letterbox drop survey.

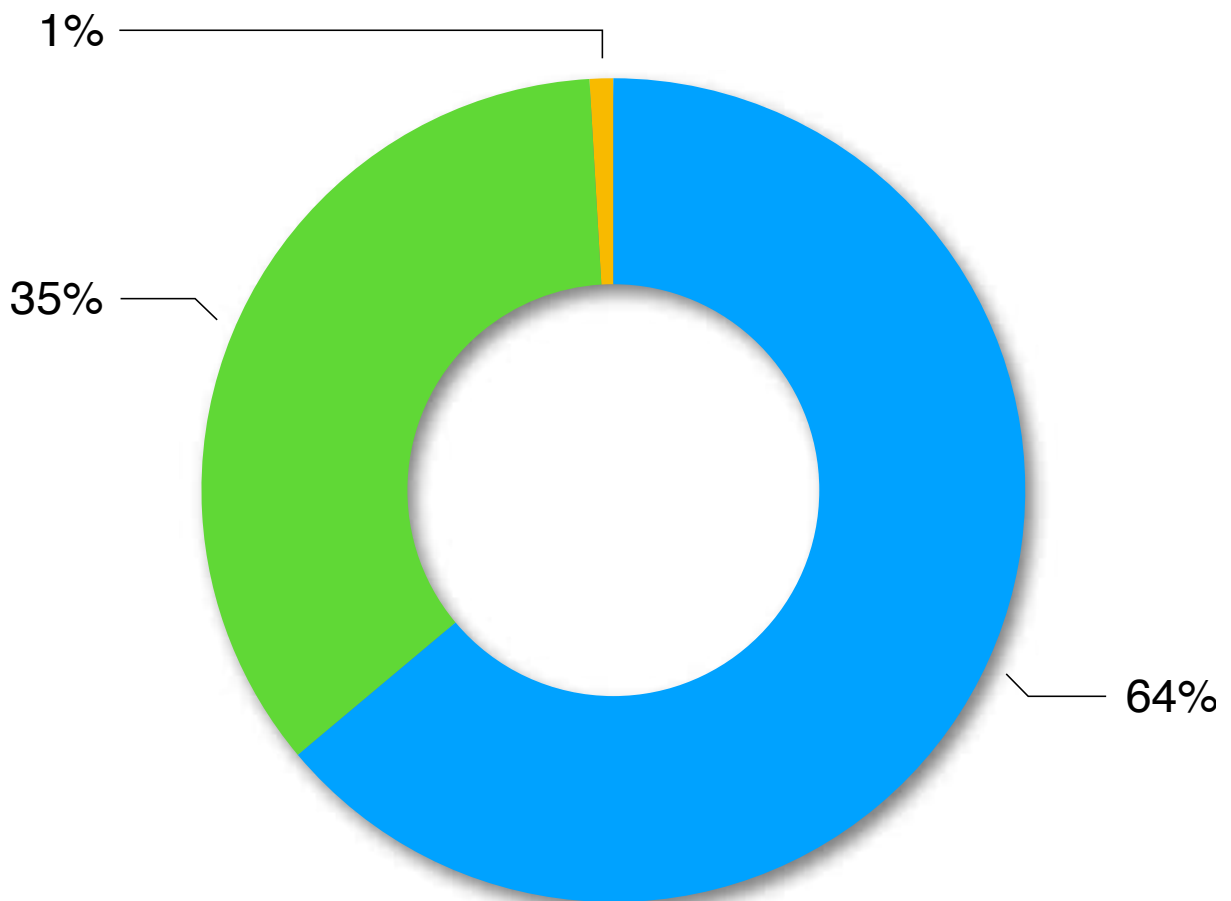

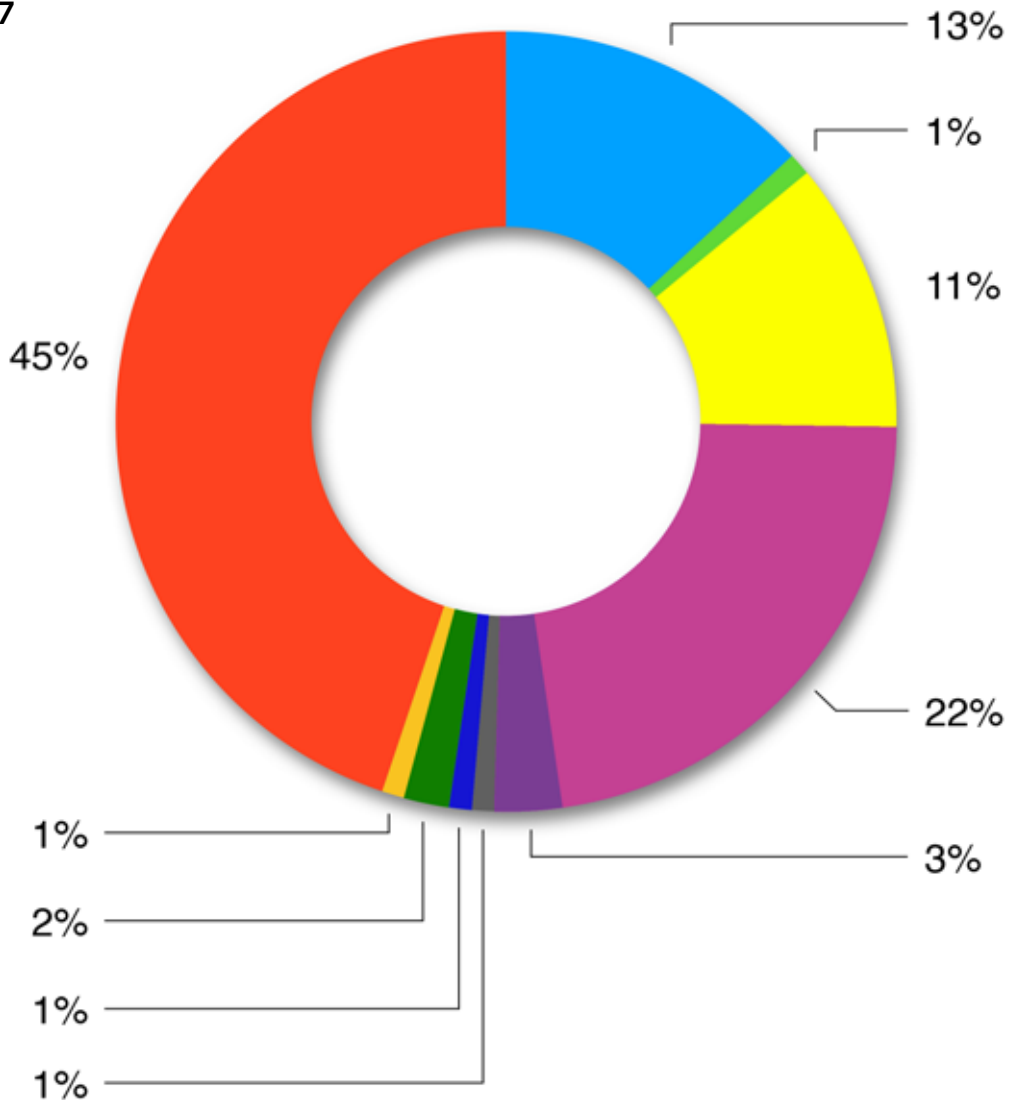

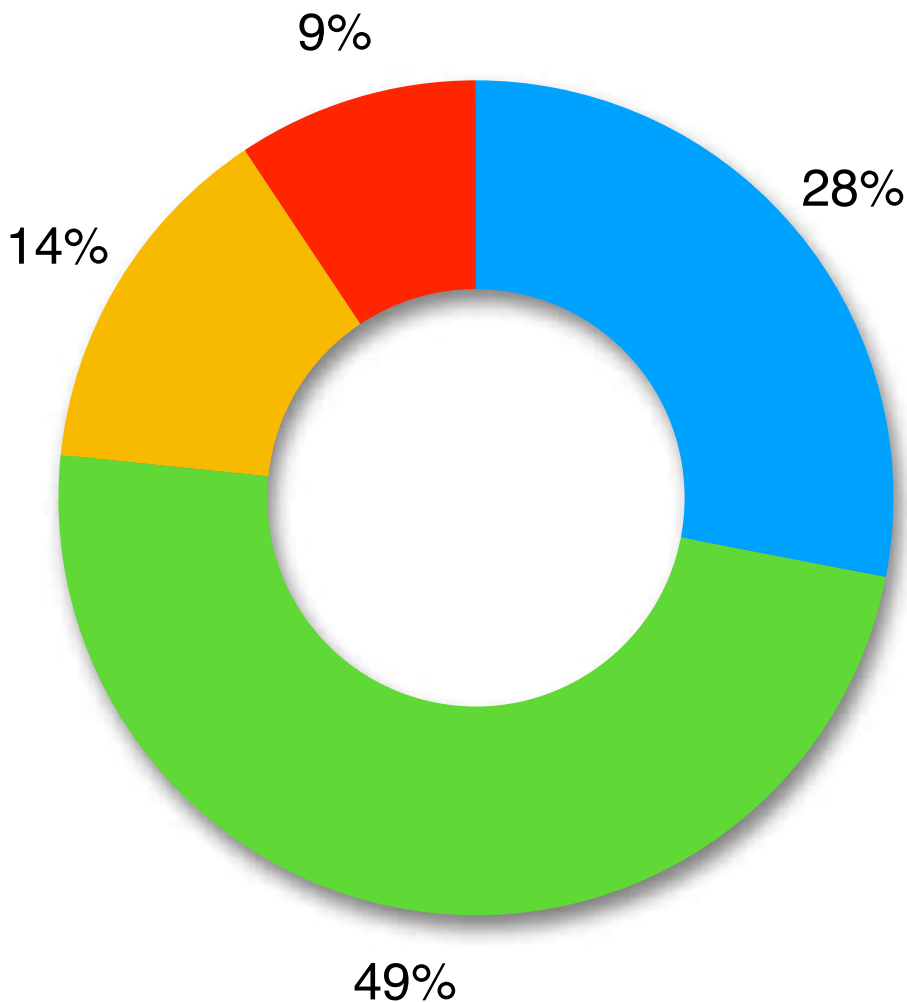
Question 3 - 108 RESPONSES
